Burt Bacharach studied for a time with Darius Milhaud (one of the group of French composers known as 'Les Six'), played in jazz bands, and then turned towards song writing. Alfie was written with his lyricist, Hal David, but did not appear in the 1966 film with Michael Caine, in fact, the original music was by Sonny Rollins.

Hints & Tips: When there are chords in the right hand after passages of single notes, keep the melodic line smooth by playing the chords gently. The first bar is a good example.
